Below you will find a typical label example for this catalog item.

DANGER

- Causes severe skin burns and eye damage
- Harmful if inhaled • May cause respiratory irritation • May be corrosive to metals • May be harmful if swallowed.
- Wear protective gloves, protective clothing, eye protection, face protection • Do not breathe mist or vapors • Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area
- Wash face, hands and any exposed skin thoroughly after handling • Keep only in original container • Absorb spillage to prevent material damage.

FIRST AID: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or physician. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. DO NOT induce vomiting or give baking soda. If conscious, give milk or water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
